The APM & Distributed Tracing Fundamentals certification exam is for individuals who can effectively demonstrate an overall knowledge of Datadog's APM & Distributed Tracing tools, independent of a specific job role.

This exam will test and validate knowledge on the following topics:

- Understand automatic and dynamic instrumentation methods
- Understand and implement manual instrumentation
- Understand how to use APM features, including
 - Services
 - Search Syntax
 - Live Search vs Retained Search
 - Profiles
 - Deployment Tracking
 - Error Tracking
 - Span Summary
- Visualize insights using
 - Service Performance Dashboards
 - Trace Metrics
- Troubleshoot Applications using
 - Trace Search (during incidents)
 - Monitors & Alerting

Target Candidates

QUESTION TYPE

The exam only contains one type of question:

• **Multiple choice:** Has one correct response and two or more incorrect responses (distractors)

Select the response that most accurately answers the question. Incorrect options, or distractors, are designed to appear plausible within the context of the question. Any unanswered questions will be scored as incorrect.

NUMBER OF QUESTIONS

The exam includes a total of 90 multiple-choice questions. 75 questions are scored and will count toward your final score.

PRE TEST ITEMS

The exam includes 15 pre-test (unscored) questions that do not affect your score. Datadog collects information about candidate performance on pretest questions to evaluate them for future use on exam forms. Pretest questions are not identified to the candidate on the exam.
